Dues are payable immediately upon notification of election. The Institute operates on a fiscal year of April 1 to March 31.

It is required, however, to pay the following amount as actual expenses of postage: \$8,000/year in case of Air Mail, and \$6,000/year in case of Sea Mail. (Please choice one. Either will do.)
